# Children's Ministry in the Nations

## Papua New Guinea

Children's ministry in Papua New Guinea is very active, especially in our Bethel Tabernacle of Praise Church.

The Always Remember Kids (ARK) ministry reaches neighbourhood children for Christ through singing, telling Bible stories, memorising Bible verses, eating and praying.

The Early Learning Mobile School (ELMS) teaches four to seven year old children how to read and write, as well as providing a foundation in God's Word.

A monthly feeding program reaches children from the Tete settlement north of Port Moresby.

The Girls' Brigade is open for girls aged six to 18 years and involves marching, bible study, songs, crafts, guest speakers, and combined fellowship with other girls brigade groups.

Lastly, Sunrise Bethel Christian School is located on the grounds of Bethel Tabernacle of Praise Church and has approximately 250 students.

# Fiji

Fiji has a population of 900,000 with almost one third aged under 15 years. With such a young population, there is a strong need to assist the young in Fiji.

Bethel Crusade Preschools began in Suva in 1994 with nine children. Since then approximately 3,000 children have been through and graduated from the preschools. Bethel Crusade Preschools have expanded to reach a total of eight preschools located throughout Fiji.

## Solomon Islands

Our CRC Gateway Church in Honiara runs normal Sunday school activities for children within the church and the surrounding area. Breakfast is provided to children after Sunday school. At the end of each month they run a missions program where children learn about missions work in other countries. A missions offering is also collected.

Gateway's children's ministry also includes visiting the children's ward at the hospital, participating in a yearly interdenominational children's rally organised by the Child Evangelism Fellowship, and learning dramas/skits and action songs to perform with the Gateway youth.

In addition to this, Gateway Church has the Gateway Kids Club which is held fortnightly on Thursdays. The Gateway team organise and collect children from the neighborhood to have a fun-filled afternoon where they participate in games and other enjoyable activities. Children are also taught the Word of God as part of the program.

## Vanuatu

Preschools are one of the main CRC children's ministries in Vanuatu. We currently have two preschools in Vanuatu. One preschool is located in Vila and the other in Eratap.

In addition to running a preschool, our team in Vila provides a daycare and a feeding program to preschool students.

Daycare is provided after preschool hours for children with working parents. After parents finish work they collect their children by 5pm.

The feeding program includes lunch and dinner and is available for these students that stay on later.

In addition to this, every year our team in Vanuatu runs one week of training in letter and sound for preschool teachers from government and private preschools.

This training is run with the support of Goolwa church in South Australia and with the help of Bernice and Garry Fraser.

- Training of senior teacher, Anitha Adam, who will train at our future preschool teacher training centre in PNG in 2019









## Sri Lanka

Many children have been affected in some way by the civil war that took place in Sri Lanka and have been displaced for various reasons. We believe that in order for children to reach their full potential in life they need a safe and supportive environment around them. This is the focus of our Sri Lanka children's homes.

Our children's homes have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. We now have two homes for girls and one home for boys on another property. Our children's homes are currently running a three year tax deductible project through Global Development Group. To find out more please visit www.gdg.org.au/InfoJ982N

In addition to the children's homes, we also have a preschool in Sri Lanka. There are currently approximately 20 children enrolled in the Door of Hope Preschool which is located in Vavuniya in the Northern Province of Sri Lanka.

## Philippines

Hundreds of children are ministered to weekly in the Philippines through children's outreach, feeding programs, School Assistance Program (SAP), a children's home and Christian schools.

Children's feeding programs include feeding, Bible teaching, praying, world missions orientation, games, memory verses, and praise and worship. More than 12,000 children are reached around the Philippines through these programs.

SAP provides the basic needs for children to attend school (i.e. basic school fees, school supplies and uniform). This program consists of assistance only rather than a full sponsorship program. In 2018 the CRC is sponsoring 262 children.

- Regular support for full-time workers and for CRC Philippines to raise more support to fund the expanding children's work throughout the nation

- For all of the children to spread the Word of God and live for Him

## Myanmar

The Myanmar Project has been running for seven years in Mandalay. In partnership with Ps Andrew from Myanmar, Portlife Church now assists nine formerly at-risk children. They live at the Life House, attend a local school and are thriving in a small family setting. God has enlarged our vision to include more children and families in Mandalay, so we now work alongside the Beulah Preschool, as they outwork their vision to care for younger children.

## Gambodia

Churches related to the CRC are active in children's ministry with many outreach activities and English classes for children in villages. On 1st June 2018, International Children's Day, our churches in Kampong Chhnang area ran a successful children's outreach in a rural village. Over 100 children enjoyed games, singing, drama, presenting the Gospel, gifts and food.

- For effective communication of the living God to children in rural villages









## Uganda

The Upward Junior School in Uganda is located in a rural town four hours north of the capital city of Uganda, Kampala. In 2018 the school's enrolment exceeds five hundred students. The initial vision of the school was to provide education for deaf children. The school now has fully equipped classrooms and trained teachers. Their first five deaf children began in the second term of 2018.

## Ghapa

in Ghana have developed a school, Terri International Christian Academy, which has 215 students. In addition to this, students meet their teachers twice a week to study more about Jesus Christ, hold quarterly community outreach where they share the Gospel amongst themselves and other children, and have a singing group which ministers every Sunday at the church's main service.

# Brazil

The Igreja Batista da Família (The Family Baptist Church) in Simões Filho, Brazil has been working at developing their children's ministry. Children are taught about Jesus, missions, God's Word and evangelism. Evangelistic children's services are held where many children are invited. In the second half of 2018, in addition to Sunday school, children's worship services will be run on a fortnightly basis.

## United States

Faith Christian School in Walhalla, South Carolina is associated with Faith Christian Center, our national CRC centre in the United States of America. The school offers a Christ-centered innovative learning experience, where character development and the role of the parent is paramount. Faith Christian School offers an individualised course of study that meets the needs of each student, enabling them to excel at their own pace, encouraging them to achieve and 'want' to learn

## Australia and Additional Ministries

The challenge for the church in Australia is to maintain relevance in an increasingly secular and individualised culture. Mainline churches are in decline. Most children are biblically illiterate and have had little exposure to the Gospel. Regular church attendance has also dropped.

As darkness increases, our light will only shine brighter. We have an opportunity to connect with our communities and show them the love of Jesus. Many CRC churches are running effective school breakfasts, school holiday programs and weekly outreach programs. We also have some CRC churches and personnel outreaching to Indigenous Australians.

Pray for more leaders in Australia with a heart to reach this generation with the Gospel. Also pray for the children to develop a personal faith, fall in love with God's Word and be effective missionaries to their schools, sports clubs etc.

In addition to the nations mentioned in this booklet, we also have CRC children's work in India, Thailand, New Zealand and the United Kingdom. Our CRC personnel in these nations are seeking to impact the lives of the younger generation with various ministries to children. Pray that all children will be radically impacted with the Gospel of Christ, and with the mission of the church to take the Good News to all people.
